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What are we going to learn and do in art class?

Students will explore a variety of art making techniques this semester. Many art mediums will be used throughout the semester. Student projects will make connections to art history, one's own thoughts and imagination while also making connections to a variety of cultures past and present. Students will use their sketchbooks for planning and sketching before beginning a project, sketch notes and a space for self-expression. The elements of art and principles of design will be used to guide students in the process of art making while also aiding in the critique process of their own artwork and artwork of others.
